MEPS NHC-001F: Facility Characteristics Round 1 File

Release date: March 1997

This data file provide information on a nationally representat of nursing homes and current residents as of January 1, 199 those nursing homes.

The first file consists of data obtained in Round 1 from the ne home facilities and contains variables pertaining to character detailed information on the facility's structure (e.g., part of a number of beds by licensing and certification categories, own special care units by type and size, and staffing (n=952 nurs

The second file is a person-level file that contains point-in-tin Round 1. Persons sampled as January 1, 1996 residents and responding are included (n=3,747 residents). Data items incluse insurance coverage, and medical conditions as reported by facan be linked to the facility-level file in order to make person for facility-level characteristics (however, it is not possible to controlling for person characteristics given the sample design

The following statistics were derived from these data:

Almost 66% of U.S. nursing homes in 1996 were operated for-profit.

Over 80% of nursing home residents needed help with 3 or more activities of daily living.

Almost half of all nursing home residents have some form of dementia.
