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MEPS NHC-005: Cross-Sectional Health Status Data Control from Nursing Home Sources, Time 1 and 2 Data

Nursing Home Component data files are not available for pull but researchers with approved projects can access the files a <u>AHRQ Data Center</u>.

This person-level file contains data obtained in Rounds 1, 2, a sample of 5,899 persons; one record per person. Most of t the nursing home are based on the Resident Assessment For Administration (HCFA), know as the minimum data set (MDS sample person's cognitive skills, hearing and communication continence, psychosocial well-being, active diagnoses and im sores, and use of restraints. Health status data is collected u Questionnaire. The survey design permits the interviewer to from the MDS, and also provides a questionnaire mechanism no MDS forms.

Among persons who used a nursing home any time during 1 derived from these data:

2,215,000 persons were alive as of December 31, 1996 while date.

1,276,000 persons had 6 limitations in activities of daily livin 328,000 had four, 377,000 had two to three, 188,000 had or limitations.
